The national curriculum for languages aims to ensure that all pupils:

- Understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources
- Speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussion and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation
- Can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt
- Discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studied.

French is taught as our KS2 Modern Foreign Language. We follow the NYCC French Scheme of Work.

## INTENT:

Our intent in languages (French) is that:

- all pupils develop key language learning skills, as set out in the national curriculum.
- the learning of a language provides a valuable educational, social and cultural experience for our pupils.
- it helps them to develop communication skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing, with an aim of making substantial progress in one language.
- children's knowledge of how language works will be developed to lay the foundations for further language learning in future.
- learning another language will give children a new and broader perspective on the world, encouraging them to understand their own cultures and those of others, which feeds into our focus on global learning.


## IMPLEMENTATION:

We will implement our intent by:
In KS2, children are taught in weekly 30 minutes sessions with class teachers reinforcing their learning outside of lessons where possible. We aim for our children to develop an appreciation of songs and stories in French throughout their time at the school.

We follow the NYCC French Scheme of Work whilst acknowledging children's different learning styles. The children learn through active participation in actions, rhymes, stories, song, grammar focus, video clips, sentence structure, dictionary work, book making and many more creative ways to extend, embed and combine language skills.

Pupils will be taught to:

- Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding
- Explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words
- Engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others; seek clarification and help
- Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures
- Develop accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others understand when they are reading aloud or using familiar words and phrases
- Present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences
- Read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing
- Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language
- Broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced into familiar written material, including through using a dictionary
- Write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences, to express ideas clearly
- Describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing
