BENEDICT’S LAW – NEW STATUTORY DUTY FOR ALL SCHOOLS FROM SEPTEMBER 2026

What is Benedict’s Law?

Benedict’s Law introduces new allergy safety requirements for schools in England from September 2026.

It is named after 5-year-old Benedict Blythe, who sadly died from anaphylaxis at school in 2021 after mistakenly being given cow’s milk, to which he was known to be allergic.

Benedict’s Law will introduce a series of protective measures designed to improve allergy safety in schools. These measures are presented in the Department for Education’s new [Allergy safety in schools](#) statutory guidance, which schools will need to comply with as a legal requirement.

Who does it apply to?

Benedict’s Law and the new [Allergy safety in schools statutory guidance](#) will apply to all local authority-maintained schools, academies and pupil referral units in England. The guidance is not statutory for school-attached nurseries and early years settings.

What does this mean for parents?

Parents/carers are responsible for providing the school with accurate and up-to-date information regarding their child's allergies, supplying prescribed emergency medication, participating in the development and review of Individual Healthcare Plans, notifying the school of any changes to medical needs, and supporting the school's allergy management procedures. Parents/carers should ensure any emergency medication remains in date and should work collaboratively with the school to promote a safe and inclusive environment for all pupils.

We ask all parents to complete the Notification of Medical Conditions and Allergies Form, to be sent home on Wednesday 9th September 2026 and returned to school by Friday 11th at the latest please.

Once returned we will be compiling an Allergy Register and will invite parents of children with allergies, intolerances and sensitivities to attend a meeting to ensure we have an Individual Care Plan and an Action Plan in place.

Until the Allergy Register is completed and disseminated to all staff we will be sharing the ingredients of any food to be given to children in advance to ensure that you can check ingredients and notify us of any concerns or foods that your child is unable to eat.

In addition, we ask all parents to ensure their child/ children's water bottles, lunch box and snack box for break and After School Clubs are clearly labelled with their child's name. These will be checked daily and if they are not named a member of staff will label with a permanent marker.

FEDERATION FRIDAY:

We will continue with our joint Federation Friday's which improved the impact on progression and development in Mathematics and English last academic year.

Federation Friday will not be undertaken during the second half of the Autumn Term and the first half of the Spring Term due to the potential for disruptive weather.

SWIMMING:

Swimming lessons will be delivered during Federation Friday this year at St Alban's, Ampleforth College for all our Federation children in Years 3 – 5.

Year 3 – 5 children will have swimming lessons each Friday 1pm – 2pm for a five-week block 18.09.2026 – 16.10.2026 and a second five-week block 19.02.2027 – 19.03.2027.

FOREST SCHOOLS:

As a result of our current Forest School Provider starting a full-time teaching post in September 2026 and the Governments removal of the PE and Sports Premium Funding, we have made the difficult decision to not provide externally led Forest Schools sessions.

The children will continue to have regular Outdoor Learning in the Forest School area led by school staff focussed on practical, social, emotional, and environmental skills, fostering independence, resilience, creativity, and teamwork implemented through our PE and Outdoor Learning Policy.
